



**Owen—Advanced Voice & Cello, Beginner Piano, Percussion, Guitar, Bass Guitar, Violin, Viola and Upright Bass**

Owen is originally from Norway, Maine. He has a B.A. in music composition and history from Keene State College in Keene, New Hampshire, where he graduated summa cum laude. He also worked at the college for two years, operating The Braille Music Project, providing alternatives to written music for visually impaired music students. He currently

teaches and performs in the Twin Cities area. Owen composed the score for Finders Productions' 2008 film "Unstable," as well as the 2010 independently released film "All That's Left."

He has been a studio musician and arrangement consultant on several other film productions. In addition to his works in composition, Owen was the tenor soloist in the premier performance of Lawrence Seigel's "Kaddish," a holocaust memorial piece now being performed worldwide. He has also served as the cellist and primary arranger for the Tick Tock String Trio since its founding in 2010, and plays a variety of instruments in a number of classical and rock groups. Owen studied composition with Dr. Heather Gilligan, voice with Dr. Carroll Lehman, and music history with Dr. Joseph Darby.
